Q How does Bluetooth Technology work in hearing aids and with other devices?

A Patients often ask me about Bluetooth technology, its origin and how it applies to hearing aids. I tell them that don't be surprised if one day we're able to make phone calls, check emails, text-messages, and improve our hearing all with one hearing device. We already see the beginnings of that. Bluetooth is the name for a short-range, digital, radio-frequency technology that transmits voice and data over short distances between compatible electronic devices. A fun fact: the name refers to Danish King Harald "Bluetooth" Blatand, who unified Denmark and Norway (and, as a footnote, where many of the world's high-quality hearing technologies come from). The king's nickname comes from one of his favorite dishes – you guessed it – blueberries!
