Q I tried hearing aids before, but they were too noisy. Is there anything new I can try?

A First you should know that today's more advanced hearing aids are much better equipped to reduce unwanted background noise. One reason for this is dual-microphone technology. A recent survey by a very respected expert in the field of Audiology found that only 29% of patients with single microphone hearing aids were satisfied, compared to 85% whose hearing aids were equipped with dual microphones. Assistive listening devices can also help reduce noise. Understand that getting used to hearing aids requires patience and practice, especially in noise. Your new hearing aids should be worn every day.
